

Adding TruFleet Plus Interface to Scout Console Via Action Button

Guide for embedding the TruFleet Plus web interface into an existing Scout Console Via Action Button.

Prerequisites

- Administrative access to Scout Manager
- IP address or DNS name of your TruFleet Plus Server
- A working Scout Central Distributor for deployment

Setup Instructions

1. Prepare the TruFleet Screen

- 1. Enable edit mode
 - Click the lock icon in Scout Manager to unlock configuration changes.
- 2. Open the Configuration tab

The Configuration tab is pinned to the left side of Scout Manager. Click it to reveal Consoles and Screens.

- 3. Create the TruFleet screen
 - o Under Screens, right-click and choose Add New Screen.
 - Name it something like "TruFleet View" and save.
- 4. Add the Browser Pro element
 - Expand Screens → TruFleet View and select it.
 - o From the Toolbox, drag **Browser Pro** onto the canvas, sizing it to fill the view.
- 5. Configure the TruFleet URL
 - o With Browser Pro selected, open its Properties.
 - Set URL to:

http://<Your-TruFleet-IP-or-DNS>/

- Append any login or path segments if required.
- 6. Save and exit edit mode

Click the lock icon to lock configuration, then save your project.



2. Add an Action Button to Your Existing Screen

- 1. Enable edit mode (if not already unlocked)
- 2. Open the Configuration tab
- Select your existing console's screen
 Under Screens, find the screen your users normally see (e.g., "Main View") and select
 it.
- 4. Drag in an Action Button
 - From the Toolbox, drag **Action Button** onto the canvas.
 - Position it where you want the TruFleet shortcut to live.
- 5. Configure the Action Button
 - In its Properties pane, set Action Type to Navigate to Screen.
 - o Choose the "TruFleet View" screen you created.
 - Set the Caption to something like "TruFleet."
 - Optionally pick an icon or color for quick recognition.
- Save and exit edit mode

Lock the configuration and save your project again.

3. Deploy via Scout Central Distributor

- Open Scout Central Distributor
- 2. Select the Site or specific Console
- 3. Click **Deploy** to push your changes live

Your new TruFleet View screen and the Action Button shortcut will now be available on the console.

Troubleshooting Tips

- If clicking the button shows an error:
 - Verify the TruFleet server's IP/DNS is reachable.
 - Double-check the Browser Pro URL for typos.
 - Ensure "TruFleet View" appears under **Screens** and is spelled exactly in the Action Button properties.



- If the button doesn't appear:
 - o Confirm you saved and locked edits after adding it.
 - Make sure you deployed the latest configuration via the Distributor.
